**Early voting will be conducted in the County Clerk's office from September 27, 2018 to November 5, 2018, serving every precinct under the jurisdiction of St. Clair County (excluding East St. Louis). **Voters who would like to vote early can do so during the regular business hours of 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, in the County Clerk's office, 2nd Floor, of the St. Clair County Courthouse, 10 Public Square, Belleville.**

**Grace period voting begins October 10, 2018 thru November 6, 2018. With grace period voting, you can come in to the County Clerk's office and register to vote and you must vote at that time. When registering to vote, you must have two (2) forms of identification (one must have your current name and address).**
