Anyone wanting to register, had a name change, or change their address can do so at the St. Clair County Building, 10 Public Square, 2nd Floor, County Clerk's office, Belleville, Illinois, during the business hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. In addition to the County Clerk's office, you can also register to vote at any local City/Village Hall, Township Office, library, or on our website at www.countyclerk.co.st-clair.il.us

When registering to vote, you must have two (2) forms of identification (one must have your current name and address).

Grace Period Voting begins October 10, 2018 thru November 6, 2018. With Grace Period Voting, you can come in and register to vote and you must vote at that time.
